REGULATIONS

ORGANIZER OF COMPETITION:

The Centre of Competency Based Professional Education “Liepaja Music, Art and Design Secondary School”.

GOAL OF COMPETITION:

Promotion of the professional interest of children and youth about the classical values of piano music and innovations, tendencies of modern piano music.

OBJECTIVES OF COMPETITION:

1. Motivation of the students of piano music to develop their talent and skills in various genres of music from baroque century to nowadays.
2. Improvement of creative, technical and artistic growths and stage skills of students.
3. Popularization of the values of classical music and modern innovations in piano-playing.
4. Formation of new, international relations and promotion of experience sharing between music schools in Latvia and abroad.
5. Discover and support of new talents of piano-playing.

PLACE, TIME

Place of event: Concert hall *Great Amber*, Chamber hall (Liepaja, 8 Radio Street).

Time of event: December 11, 2019.

**PARTICIPANTS OF COMPETITION, CATEGORIES, AGE,
PROGRAM OF COMPETITION, TIMING**

Participants of competition are students of education program *Keyboard musical instruments playing – Piano-playing*.

Competition shall be held in four categories, four age groups.

Program of competition: 1) J. S. Bach Polyphony; 2) Masterful composition or Etude; 3) Free selected composition

Category A	7 - 9 years	1) J. S. Bach Polyphony 2) Masterful composition or Etude 3) Free selected composition	up to 6 min
Category B	10 - 12 years	1) J. S. Bach Polyphony 2) Masterful composition or Etude 3) Free selected composition	up to 8 min
Category C	13 - 15 years	1) J. S. Bach Polyphony 2) Masterful composition or masterful concert style Etude 3) Free selected composition	up to 12 min
Category D	16 - 20 years	1) J. S. Bach Polyphony 2) Masterful composition or masterful concert style Etude 3) Free selected composition	up to 15 min

Borderdate of the age of participants is December 11, 2019.

PROVISIONS

- ✓ Competition is opened and shall be held in one round, in one day.
- ✓ Original compositions shall be performed in item 1., 2 of the program of competition.
As free selected compositions participant can select the original composition, settings, non-academic style compositions (the author of setting must be indicated in the application).
- ✓ **Number of places in each category of competition is limited and differs.**
If number of participants exceeds the number of places per category, organizers of competition shall be entitled to ask to choose and select not more than 2 – 3 participants from each school.
- ✓ **Competition participation fee is paid by all participants. In case of the limitation of participants, participation fee shall be returned.**
- ✓ **Participation fee is not returned due to the other reasons of non-appearance.**
- ✓ **Upon arrival at competition, printed music (notes) must be submitted to the jury at the moment of registration.**
- ✓ Participants of competition must perform the program by heart.
- ✓ Program of performance announced in the application cannot be changed.
- ✓ Order of performance shall be stated by the organizers of competition.
- ✓ Upon submission of application, participants accept the presence of mass media during the competition, as well as audio and video recording made by the organizers of competition.
- ✓ Participants of competition perform in concert suits.
- ✓ Costs of transport, accommodation and catering shall be covered by participants of competition.
- ✓ Participation fee – **EUR 35** from the participant.
- ✓ Participation fee must be transferred till November 10, 2019 to the following requisites:

EVALUATION AND AWARDING

- Performance of participants shall be evaluated by jury of not less than three persons, formed and approved by The Centre of Competency Based Professional Education “Liepaja Music, Art and Design Secondary School”.

- Content of jury shall be announced at the place of competition.
- Students of the members of jury commission may not participate in this competition.
- In case of the non-observance of competition regulation provisions, participants can be disqualified.
- Performance of participants shall be evaluated due to 25 points system.
- Decision of jury is complete and not disputable.
- Diplomas for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place, awards and gratitude for participation in competition shall be given to participants.
- Gratitude for training of students shall be also given to the teachers of participants.
- Jury shall be entitled not to give any award or award-winning places.
- Awarding shall take place after each category of competition.

Application procedure

- Applications for Liepaja II International pianist competition must be submitted electronically till November 4, 2019 to e-mail: sintija.piraga@lmmdv.edu.lv (application form – Annex 1).
- At the day of competition organizers of competition shall be entitled to ask to present the person attestant documentation.

Plan of event and other actual information related to shall be available after November 20, 2019 at the website of competition organizers www.lmmdv.edu.lv section „Music”, as well as shall be sent to the e-mail address of participants of competition, teachers or school indicated in the application.

Personal data processing

Upon filling in the application form, participant or his/her legal representative attests that he/she has read the regulations of competition, including, regulations of personal data processing, available at www.lmmdv.edu.lv section “Data protection”.

Till the beginning of Liepaja II International pianist competition “Piano frequency”, participant or his/her legal representative shall be entitled to ask for supplementation, correction of personal data or termination of their processing, by recalling the participation in competition.
